Dear Parent or Guardian,

The MD5M Lions Clubs wishes to inform you that it will be providing vision screening. Members of our Lions Club have been trained in the use of the Vision Screener and we can screen toddlers and infants from 6 months to 6 years of age.

The vision screener we use is capable of screening for Myopia (near-sightedness), Hyperopia (far-sightedness) and Anisocoria (pupil size deviations). In addition, Astigmatism (blurred vision), Anisometropia (unequal refractive power), and Strabismus (eye misalignment) which can result in Amblyopia (lazy-eye). The individual screening takes just a few seconds and is performed from a distance of about three feet. There is no physical contact with the child and no eye drops are administered. We will provide a print-out of the results for each child who should receive follow up care from an eye care professional which is given to your pre-school or school for forwarding to you. To have your child participate in this screening you will need to fill out and sign the parental Consent Form included with this letter.

It is important to understand that this is only a screening and does not constitute an examination or diagnosis of vision problems.
